It is a full-time partially grant funded position with an 8-10 credit hour p/semester teaching load combined with a 5-7 credit hour course reassignment for grant coordination and administration to facilitate successful pathways for UNM-Taos students into four-year colleges and STEM careers (salary: \$60K-\$63K; deadline 6/27).
